Bib Pickup: **7:30 am** each day at the Hawk Lift Welcome Area. **One designated team captain from each mountain will pick up bibs and lift passes for distribution to their athletes and coaches.**

Bib Return: **Each day, athletes will return their bibs near the finish area** after their 2nd run.

Unreturned Bibs: The athlete and their club will be billed a \$50 replacement fee for any missing bibs. Each mountain is responsible for ensuring that **all bibs are returned to NYSEF Belleayre at the conclusion of each race.**

There will be no-day of registration or add-ons! Race entry is online through Adminskiracing.

Athletes:

Lodge Access Information:

- The Longhouse Lodge is closed to the public.
- When using the Discovery or Overlook Lodges, **please do not leave belongings on or under tables.** USE LOCKERS OR CUBBIES.

Lift Line/Lift Riding Information:

- Please adhere to posted signage at lift areas and the directions of staff.
- You must have your lift pass on you in order to ride the lift.
- There is no priority loading for racers.
- Always lower the safety bar.
- Always be considerate of other skiers and riders.
- Do not ski fast around the general public or at lift areas.

Parking Lot Information:

- Lots E, F, G are closest to Lift 8 (Hawk Quad)
- Do not park or block access at Drop off areas.
- The premium parking area (in lot I) is paid parking only. Do not drive under the skier bridge in lot I.
- Belleayre Mountain does not have parking for campers.
